West 1800 North Corridor







BRIEF DESCRIPTION: West 1800 North Corridor begins at to 2000 West Street (State Highway 126) and continues westward to the Plain City border.

This also implements a corridor identified in the WFRC Regional Transportation Plan.

RECOMMENDED CORRIDOR TYPE: Category 2: Buffered Bike Lane

RECOMMENDED CORRIDOR USES: Cars, Marked bike lanes, with sidewalks for pedestrians.

CORRIDOR CONNECTIONS: 2000 West Street (SR-126), Willard Canal, Farr West Farms.

AREAS OF CONCERN:

Canal crossing, crossing at Farr West Farms, speed limits.

LEVEL OF DIFFICULTY: Easy

APPROXIMATE CORRIDOR LENGTH:

1.1 miles

RESPONSIBLE ENTITIES: Farr West City

EXISTING CONDITIONS: Asphalt paved road with curb, gutter and sidewalk. Pedestrian bridge crosses the Willard Canal on the north side.
