2700 North Commercial Corridor





BRIEF DESCRIPTION: This walking/bike corridor runs from the intersection of 2700 N & State Rd. 126 (2000 W.) east to Highway 89.

This also implements a corridor identified in the WFRC Regional Transportation Plan.

RECOMMENDED CORRIDOR TYPE:

Category 1: Separated Cycle Track, Sidewalks

RECOMMENDED CORRIDOR USES: Protected bike lanes, with sidewalks for pedestrians.

CORRIDOR CONNECTIONS: State Road 126 north and south connections. Corridor connection to Rulon Dr. and east to Pleasant View City. This corridor also has a connection to the Frontrunner station in Pleasant View City.

AREAS OF CONCERN: High traffic use, with high traffic speeds. (45 mph) and 3 stop lights (2 existing and 1 planned) Multiple business access points along roadway. Major on off ramp access for Northwest Weber county. Overcrowded road conditions make this road dangerous to use at certain times of the day. UDOT is currently looking at addressing road use. Along with providing pedestrian and cyclist access.

LEVEL OF DIFFICULTY: Easy

APPROXIMATE CORRIDOR LENGTH: 6/10th of a mile

RESPONSIBLE ENTITIES: Farr West City Pleasant View City, Weber County, UDOT.

EXISTING CONDITIONS: Asphalt paved road with curb, gutter and sidewalk on north side only.
