

Hi-Way 126 (2000 W) Corridor



BRIEF DESCRIPTION: The bike corridor follows HYW 126 as it goes through Farr West from north boundary of Farr West City at 4000 N. 2000 W. to the southern boundary of Farr West City at 800 N. 2000 W. This also implements a corridor identified in the WFRC Regional Transportation Plan.

RECOMMENDED CORRIDOR TYPE:
Category 3: Shoulder Bikeway

RECOMMENDED CORRIDOR USES:
Cars, Marked bike lanes, with sidewalks for pedestrians.

CORRIDOR CONNECTIONS: 4000 N, Higley Rd, 2700 N, 1800 N.

AREAS OF CONCERN: This road is the major north south route for cars in Farr West. With increased population and traffic in the north west part of Weber county. Any expansion of this road in the future needs to incorporate safe bike travel lanes. Since many cyclists use it now for travel.

LEVEL OF DIFFICULTY: Easy

APPROXIMATE CORRIDOR LENGTH:
6.1 miles / 9.8 km.

RESPONSIBLE ENTITIES: Farr West, UDOT

EXISTING CONDITIONS: Two lane state road. Some sidewalks in areas. No marked bike paths. Narrow road shoulders in most areas.
