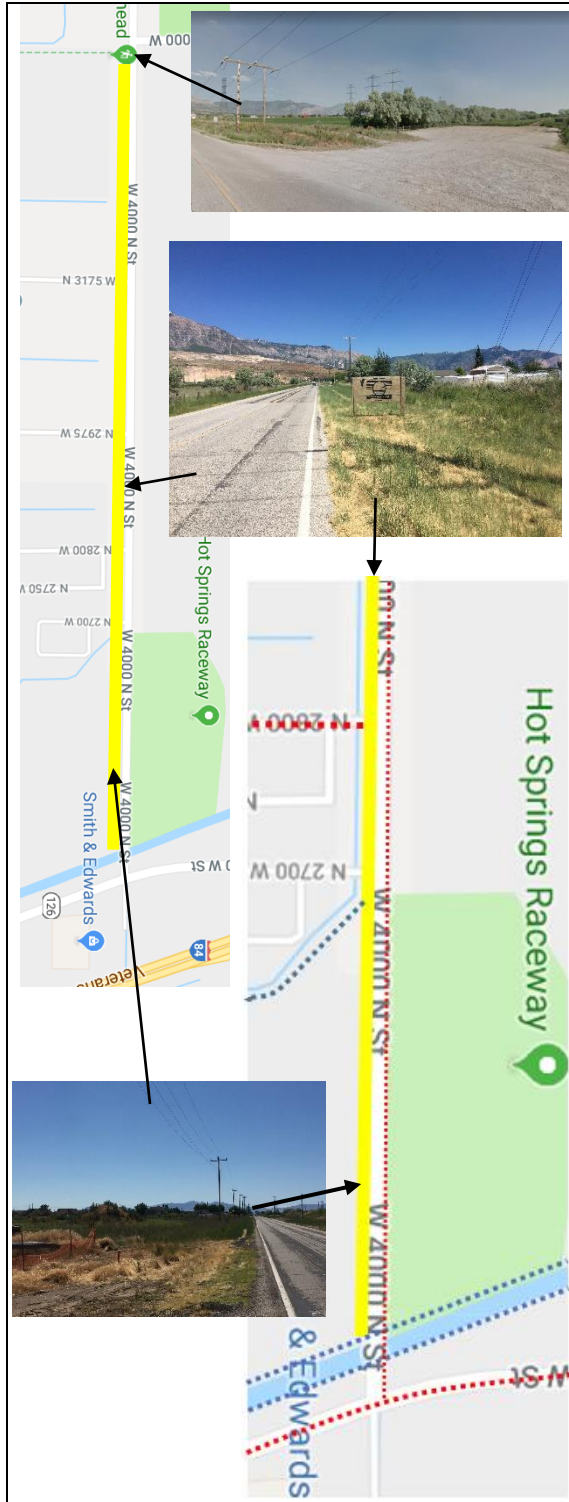


SFP to Rail Trail Connector (4000 N.)



BRIEF DESCRIPTION: This Pedestrian, equestrian, bicycle pathway would run west from Smith Family Park to Weber Pathways 'Rail Trail'. It would connect a park area containing trails and an equestrian arena to an existing trail for pedestrians & equestrians.

This also implements a corridor identified in the WFRC Regional Transportation Plan.

RECOMMENDED CORRIDOR TYPE: Trail Bikeway

RECOMMENDED CORRIDOR USES: Pedestrians, Equestrians, Bicycles

CORRIDOR CONNECTIONS: Smith Family Park, Western Drain Trail, Remuda West Corridor, Weber Pathways Rail Trail.

AREAS OF CONCERN: With the narrow area between 4000 N. roadway and Western Drain, safety concerns need to be considered. Working with other entities can be beneficial as well as challenging.

LEVEL OF DIFFICULTY: Easy

APPROXIMATE CORRIDOR LENGTH: 1.2 miles total (~2400 ft. FW)

RESPONSIBLE ENTITIES: Farr West, Weber County, Plain City

EXISTING CONDITIONS: Undeveloped shoulder
